

What to Bring to Camp

Clothes: 1. one or two pair of properly fitting basketball shoes, already broken in 2. eight pairs of new athletic socks 3. shorts 4. athletic supporters (boys) 5. bathing suit 6. casual clothes for relaxing in the evening.

Linens, etc.: 1. pillows 2. towels 3. linens 4. blankets 5. a sleeping bag is also allowed.

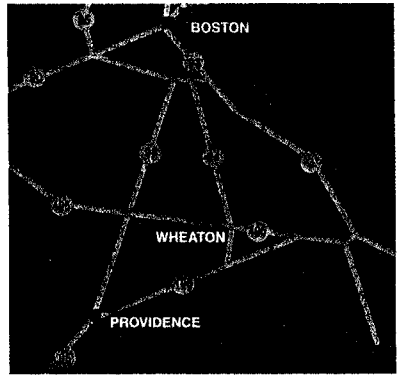
Canteen: \$35 - \$50 cash/check to be deposited into individual campers account.

Directions to Wheaton College

MEADOWS DORMITORY, NORTON, MA 02766



Wheaton is 35 miles south of Boston, Mass., and 15 miles north of Providence, R.I. The college is accessible by car from Interstate Routes 95 and 495, and by train and bus from Boston's Logan Airport.

BY CAR

From Boston and Northern New England: Take Interstate 95 South to Exit 6A, Route 495 South. Follow 495 to Exit 10, turn onto 123 West. Follow 123 for 1.5 miles to Wheaton College.

From Western Massachusetts: Take the Massachusetts Turnpike (Route 90) to Exit 11A onto Route 495 South. Follow 495 to Exit 10, turn onto 123 West. Follow 123 for 1.5 miles to Wheaton College.

From Providence and Southern New England: Take Interstate 95 North to Exit 6A. Follow Route 495 South to Exit 10, turn onto 123 West. Follow 123 for 1.5 miles to Wheaton College.

From Cape Cod: Take Route 495 North to Exit 10. Follow Route 123 West for 1.5 miles to Wheaton College

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

Amtrak provides express rail service from Boston and Providence. From Boston's South Station, an MBTA commuter rail serves Mansfield and Attleboro. The Bonanza Bus Company offers round-trip transportation from Logan Airport in Boston and from downtown Providence to Foxfield Plaza in Foxboro.
